BOARD MEETING

The Washburn Town Board met on Aug. 9, 2010 at 7p.m. at the Washburn Town Hall. Chairman Suda, Supervisor Huth, Treasurer, and Clerk were present along with 2 guests.

Minutes of last month's meeting were read and accepted.

2 building permits were issued in July.

The annual picnic held in July was reviewed. All went very well. Only suggestion was to start picnic at 11:00 a.m. with lunch at noon.

Fire ordinance will be discussed next month, as well as confirming attendance for Fall WTA workshop.

Treasurer's report was read and approved. Treasurer reported on filing small claim court for Schultz bill, with court date set for Aug. 31. Now that address correction will be made, Rosecke bill will be filed if not paid in full by Aug. 15. Treasurer has set up direct deposit for state checks.

Prices for Washburn's September 11 clean sweep were set as follows: car tires up to 16" = \$2, 17 - 20" = \$3, truck tires \$6, skid steer \$10, tractor \$25, super balloon \$50. Clerk will check on appliance cost.

Board reviewed storm clean-up.

Ian Lambert of Warrens, WI, has requested to exceed weight limit on Pray Ave. Clerk is to send Rick Dailey of Clark County Forestry and Parks a copy of Resolution 2009 - 1 notifying him that Pray Road is posted at 80,000 pounds, and he is to inform contractors as needed of this restriction. Board also will advise Lambert when logging East of Cardinal Road, to put up caution signs on the road as needed for safety; to use the Clark County landing West of Cardinal road; and to dump a minimum of one load of gravel on Cardinal Road before commencing to protect the roadbed and to help with mud and debris removal after project is complete. Clerk will take pictures of ditch before project begins.

Board reviewed road maintenance. Bills were examined and paid.
